February, 18 – 2010. *Merleau-Ponty and Some Recent Trends on Experimental Psychology*. Presented by Professor Eldon Wait (University of Zululand, Kwa Dlangezwa, South Africa) in conjunction with the SIUC Philosophy Colloquium Series.

February, 25 – 2010. *Being bound to Others: A Phenomenology of Trust*. Presented by Professor Anthony Steinbock (Southern Illinois University, United States), in conjunction with the SIUC Philosophy Colloquium Series.

During the month of March, Professor Dr. Eldon Wait presented a short-course on **A Phenomenology of the Gaze:**

- March, 02 – 2010: *The experience of the gaze of another*
- March, 16 – 2010: *Why we can't assume that any experience of the gaze of another is necessarily an illusory experience*
- March, 23 – 2010: *Simultagnosia as the disruption of the gaze*

April, 12 – 2010. *An Investigation of Derrida's La Voix et le phénomène*. Presented by Professor Eui-Geun Ryu (Silla University, South Korea).

April, 04 -2010 Professor Françoise Dastur (Professor Emeritus, University of Nice Sophia-Antilopes) presented two talks, *The question of the Other in French Phenomenology*, sponsored and hosted by the Phenomenology Research Center and *The phenomenological question of the relation with the Other: Love, Seduction and Care*, a lecture given at The Morris Library in SIUC and sponsored by the College of Liberal Arts, the Department of Philosophy, and the Phenomenology Research Center.

May, 12 – 2010. *Making the History of Human Rights our Own: Appropriation and Transgression of Intentional History*. Presented by Johannes Servan.

Also, during this period the Phenomenology Research Center hosted a total of ten meeting for our study group, The Phenomenology Research Group.
